Granulomatous gastroenterocolitis in childhood has many causes, the most common being the intestinal pseudo-obstruction syndrome and the chronic inflammatory bowel disease granulomatous polycolitis. In the other ways gastrointestinal disorders are rare, and it is essential for medical colleagues to recognise the symptoms and clinical pattern of their occurrence. The aetiological diagnosis is made clinically, histologically and by the culture of the bacteria. The most common bacteria involved are Yersinia and Mycobacterium. Treatment is only based on corticosteroid administration, and a combination with antibiotics is often necessary. Syria has agreed to allow aid convoys into the two besieged villages of Qusayr and Taldou in the country's southwest corner, a Syrian opposition source told AFP on Sunday. There was no immediate confirmation from the Syrian authorities, but it was the first breakthrough in a month-long period of relative calm on the divided frontier which has seen multiple mortar fire incidents from each side. "After three days of discussions we have resolved to open up Qusayr and Taldou to aid deliveries," said the source, who spoke on condition of anonymity because he was not authorised to speak to the media. The deal was reached after an overnight meeting involving a UN special envoy, the Syrian National Coalition and the Syrian government, the source added. The Syrian opposition charged it was a suspension of hostilities more concerned with sowing more mistrust between the sides than winning humanitarian aid into rebel-held areas. The deadline on aid deliveries to Qusayr and Taldou expires at midday (0900 GMT) on Monday, with little sign of access yet. Despite US president Barack Obama's recent promise of increased aid, it is only the first tranche of aid the UN has promised for the two villages under a strategy built on the two-month ceasefire.
